Proverbs 16:5 (KJV): Everyone that is proud in heart is an abomination to the LORD: though hand joins in hand, he shall not be unpunished.

Proverbs 16:18 (KJV): Pride goeth before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall.

Proverbs 21:4 (KJV): A high look, and a proud heart, and the plowing of the wicked, is sin.

Proverbs 29:23 (KJV): A man's pride shall bring him low: but honor shall uphold the humble in spirit.

1 Timothy 3:6 (KJV): Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he falls into the condemnation of the devil.

One of the Apocrypha books no longer in the Bible says:

Ecclesiasticus 10:13 (KJV): For pride is the beginning of sin, and he that hath it shall pour out abomination...
